

Make a Beanpole Tipi

STEP I: ASSEMBLE SIDES

Lay down 9 garden stakes about six inches apart. Nail each stake to a cross stake on the top (opposite from the pointed ends) and one cross stake about 1/3 of the way up from the bottom.

STEP 2: BIND SIES TOGETHER

With two identical panels made, bind the two panels together with wire at the top, forming the


STEP 3: STAKE THE TIPI

and force the pointed ends of the inches to hold it in place.

STEP 4: PLANT THE BEANS!

Plant scarlet runner beans at the base of each pole so as they grow, they can wind up the poles and fill in the sides. Other types of fast-growing vines can also be used.

Materials



- ☐ 4' Long Wooden Garden Stakes
- Metal wire
- ☐ Wire Cutters
- **Hammer**
- ¬ Nails
- ☐ Scarlet Runner Beans
- ☐ Chicken Wire (Optional)


(Rabbits like to eat young shoots of pole beans. Stake chicken wire around your teepee to keep the rabbits away. After the beans are large enough to vine up the sides, remove the wire.)
